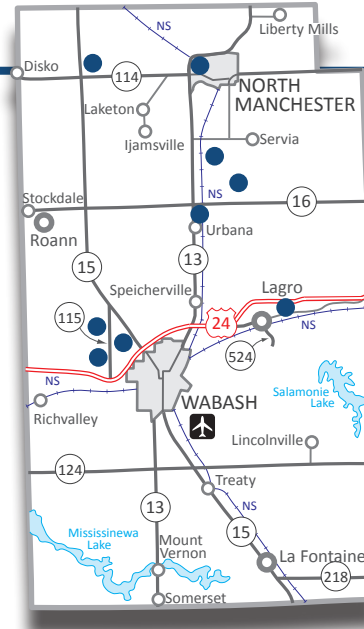

### FARM BUSINESS

Almost 10.6% of farmland in Northeast Indiana is located in Wabash County, while comprising only 6.7% of all farms in Northeast Indiana.

Wabash County also makes up the following for Northeast Indiana:

- 9.6% of cattle and calves sales
- 23.3% of hogs and pigs inventory
- 28.8% of hogs and pigs sales
- 10.3% of sheep and lambs sold
- 6.1% of milk goats sold
- 6.6% of wheat for grain
- 6.8% of apple farms
- 18.2% of nut farms
- 12.8% of maple syrup farms
- 23.6% of maple syrup gallons
